

FLAMENCO CLASSES at LOS TARANTOS

TERMS and CONDITIONS

1. Payment is by terms of 8 consecutive weeks, unless there is a public holiday in which the week is automatically brought forward.
2. Students must pay in full at beginning of each term.
3. Students will be allowed to pro-rate for any planned absences, but cannot carry forward unused term fees into the next term. All missed classes must be made up within the duration of the term with any other flamenco class of equal value.
4. Students that join midway into a term pay a pro-rated rate for the current term but full rate in new term.
5. Los Tarantos deserves the right to amend / change/cancel classes at the studio's discretion.
6. Los Tarantos will not be held responsible for any accidents/mishaps occurred or injury sustained directly or indirectly in classes.
7. Los Tarantos deserves the right to refuse or stop a student from participating in a class if he/she is deemed to be inappropriate or pose a threat to the other students at the studio's sole discretion.
8. There is strictly no smoking in the studios.

FLAMENCO ATTIRE

1. New comers can come in a pair of thick-heeled shoes and comfortable attire.
2. Students who attend ongoing classes will need to come in Flamenco shoes, and Flamenco skirt for females.
3. Those who, like to purchase flamenco shoes and skirts from us can do so at our Flamenco shop or can purchase your own separately. Los Tarantos does not require a standard uniform for our classes.
